Admission Test The Test for Admission into Catholic High School (TACHS) is scheduled for November 5, 2011.

Admission Criteria Each year, about 2,500 students apply to us for the 400 available seats. Admission is based primarily on marks from grades 6, 7 and 8, and on the results of the admission test. Be sure that your teacher or guidance counselor mails us your marks from grades 6, 7 and 8 on the Ninth Grade Applicant Record form by December 12th. Preference for admission is given to students who list Molloy as their first choice. (Choice does not affect scholarship awards, however.) First choice candidates with marks that average in the nineties are good candidates for admission.

Open House Sunday, October 16, 2011, 11 AM TO 4 PM.

Location Molloy is located at the intersection of Main Street and Queens Boulevard, directly behind the Briarwood public library, and about 5 blocks east of the Kew Gardens county offices. **Grand Central West:** Exit 17-168 Street. At the fourth traffic light on the service road, make a left onto Main St. Stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal. **Grand Central East:** Exit 14-Union Tpke. Take the first available right turn onto Main Street. Stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal. **Van Wyck South:** Exit 11-Jewel Ave. Left on Jewel to Main St. Go right on Main, proceed about 1.7 miles. Stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal. **Van Wyck North:** Exit 9-Queens Blvd. Make the first available right onto Hoover Avenue. Make a right on Main Street, stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal.

Scholarship Competition

If your seventh grade final marks in language arts, math, social studies and science average to 93.0% or better, you're qualified to participate in Molloy's Scholarship Competition. (It isn't necessary that each subject be a 93 or better, but that the average of the four subjects is at least 93. Add up the four final marks: If the total is 372 or better, you qualify). **While a 93 average is required for the scholarship competition, it is not a requirement for admission to the school.**

These partial and full academic scholarships are awarded based on your marks, your score on the TACHS Entrance Exam, and your performance on our Scholarship Competition. *Some special scholarships honor firefighters lost at the World Trade Center attack, and for these, preference is given to children of firefighters who should attach a one-page essay about themselves to this application.* All scholarships are granted at the sole discretion of the administration of Archbishop Molloy High School.

The Competition will be held on **Saturday, December 3, 2011** from 9:00 to 11:15 a.m. It includes short-answer questions on a wide variety of topics including history, literature, mathematics, geography, science, art, music and more! There's also an essay that tests your ability to write clearly and logically.

If you qualify, clip the form below and attach a copy of your seventh grade report card, showing that the average of your final marks in Language Arts, math, social studies and science is at least 93%. **This requirement is strictly adhered to for all schools and all academic programs.** Additionally, scholarship competitors must include Archbishop Molloy as one of their three high school choices on the TACHS Test. **Mail after Sept. 1 but before November 10 to**
