Admission

Last year, 2,500 applied for the 400 seats available. Successful first choice applicants had 6th, 7th and 8th grade marks consistently in the 90's and scored in the top quarter on the TACHS Test. All choices are considered, but preference is given to first choice applicants. You can register via the internet at www.tachsinfo.com or by phone at 1 866 618-2247. Tuition

\$7,480+ \$250 registration; no other fees.

Location

One block from the intersection of Queens Boulevard and Main Street, in Briarwood, Queens. Four blocks east of the county offices in Kew Gardens.

Transportation

The F train stops in front of the school at the Briarwood-Van Wyck Station. The Main Street Q44, Q20A, Q20B and the Queens Boulevard Q60 buses stop in front of the school. The Union Turnpike Q-46, the Lefferts Boulevard Q-10 and the Metropolitan Avenue Q-54 buses stop within a short walk of the school.

By Car

Grand Central West: Exit 17 - 168 Street. At the fourth traffic light on the service road, make a left onto Main Street. Stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal.

Grand Central East: Exit 14 - Union Turnpike. Take the first available right turn onto Main Street. Stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal.

Van Wyck South: Exit 11 - Jewel Avenue. Left on Jewel to Main Street. Go right on Main, proceed about 1.7 miles. Stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal.

Van Wyck North: Exit 9 - Queens Blvd. Make the first available right onto Hoover Avenue. Make a right on Main Street, stay in the right lane at the flashing yellow signal.

Curriculum

Challenging college-preparatory program for all students. Advanced Placement courses for college credit are offered at all grade levels, including freshman year. 99% of our graduates attend college, 55% with academic scholarships. Two-thirds earn college credit before graduating from Molloy.
