Applicant Record Applicants must have their present school send a copy of their marks from grade 6, 7, and the first trimester of grade 8 by December 15. A form for this purpose is included with the TACHS exam. If you don't have a form, have your teacher or guidance counselor send us a copy of your transcript showing your sixth, seventh and eighth grade marks by December 15.

Scholarship Competition Students whose final seventh grade marks in English, math, history and science average to 93.0 or higher are invited to participate in December's scholarship competition. Applications are available in the local schools or on our web site www.molloyhs.org. Click on admissions. Applications for the scholarship competition must be received by November 10.

Recommendations

Admission to Archbishop Molloy High School is based primarily on the marks earned in the sixth, seventh and first trimester of eighth grade and on the results of the TACHS Entrance Examination. Each year, 2,500 students apply for admission to the ninth grade. Admission to Archbishop Molloy is competitive. Successful first choice candidates have elementary school grades consistently in the nineties and score in the top quarter on the admission test. Preference is given to students who list Molloy as their first choice high school. Second and third choice applicants need higher grades to be admitted.

Some additional consideration is given to brothers and sisters of current students and to children or brothers and sisters of alumni. **Such additional consideration does not guarantee admission, however.** The school must balance this consideration with fairness to others who are the first in their family to apply.
